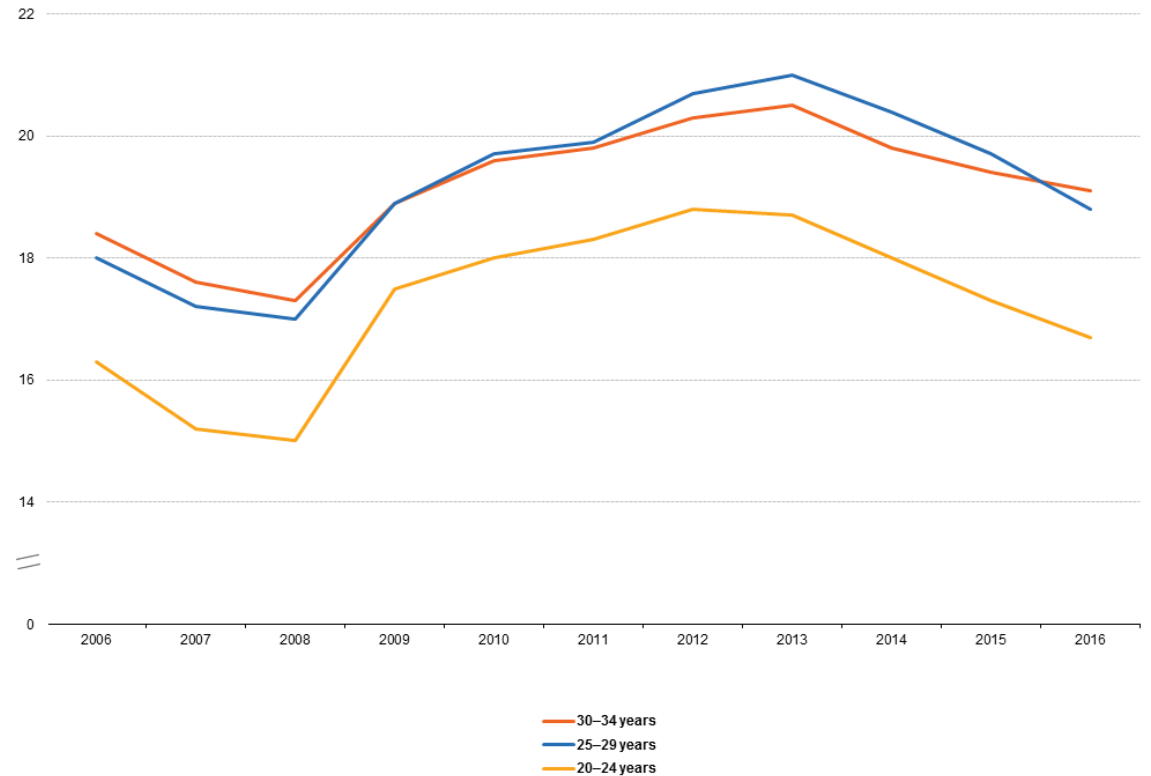

Network of young offenders and NEET



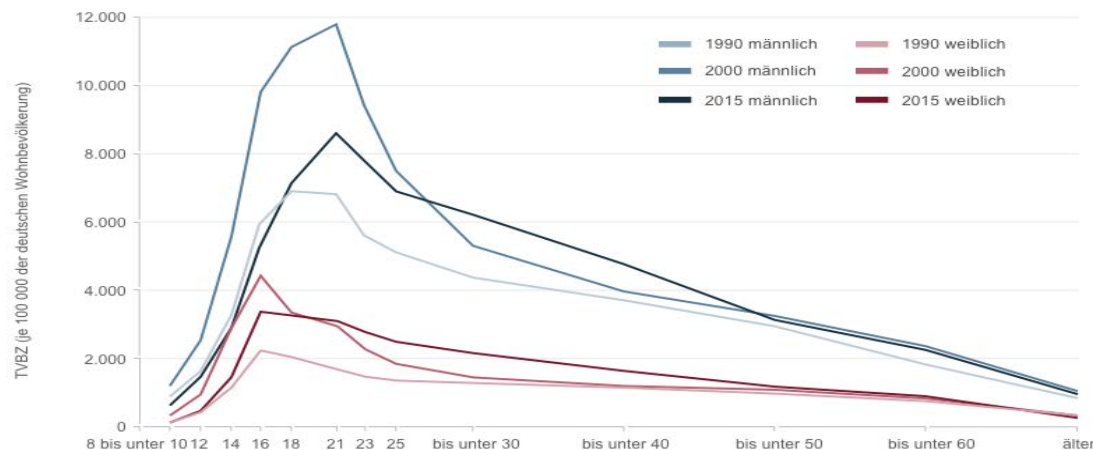
Share of young people neither in employment nor in education and training, (NEET) by age, EU-28

Deutsche Tatverdächtige nach Altersgruppen, Geschlecht und nach ausgewählten Jahren



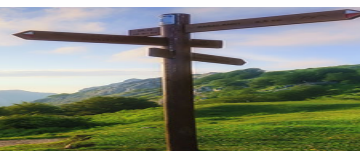
